



# **Uniform Policy**

## Introduction

At the Mayflower Federation, we believe that school uniform helps to develop the sense of identity, pride, belonging and community. At the Federation, our uniform policy is gender neutral. This means that, whilst we expect all of our children to wear school uniform, the rules for boys and girls are the same and we do not insist that they wear specific items of clothing. From the items detailed below, children are free to choose the uniform they wish to wear.

Letters will be sent home where and when needed to remind parents about our uniform expectations.

Pinafore	Grey	<p><b>Items with School Logo</b></p> <p>These items, and a few others, are available from school at cost price. This is the cheapest place to buy uniform with the school logo and it can be ordered via the school office. Payment must be made via parent pay.</p> <p>Book bags and PE bags are also available.</p>
Jumper	Grey with school logo	
Polo Shirt (EYFS Only)	Burgundy with school logo	
Sweatshirt (EYFS Only)	Grey with school logo	
PE Shorts	Burgundy	
PE Track Bottoms	Burgundy or Navy	
PE Top	Navy Round Neck T-Shirt with school logo. A plain Navy sweatshirt is allowed during cold weather	
Tights/Socks	Grey	
Hijab	Navy, black or grey	Plain fabric only, not patterned or sequined
Shoes	Black school shoes or ankle height boots. Trainers are not permitted	
PE Pumps	Black plimsolls for indoors and black trainers for outdoor PE	
Hair	Plain accessories only	Hair that is longer than shoulder length must be tied back - no shaved patterns
Jewellery / cosmetics / body art	For health & safety reasons - small stud earrings / small chains of religious significance only. Children must be able to remove these themselves and will be asked to do so for PE lessons. Nail varnish, make up and temporary tattoos are not permitted to be worn in school.
