# Fix a Bike Workshop

The FIX A BIKE workshop in Year 5 was a great success! The workshop aimed to teach children general bike maintenance including safety checks, puncture repairs and how to keep your bike in good condition.

This practical course enabled the children to work on their own bikes as well as the demonstration bikes. The course leaders were exceptionally impressed with the children's positive attitude to learning and their enthusiasm to ask questions about bike maintenance and road safety.

### Mobile Phones in School
