

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Draw a picture for your new teacher to show her what you enjoy doing and what you feel you are good at.

Make a picture of you caring for a fish as your pet. What would you do? What will be in the tank?

Can you create your own ocean? Have a boat and pretend to go fishing. Maybe you could use an empty box and pretend it's your boat? What kind of fish are you catching?

### Literacy

Can you find words that rhyme with log, shell, cat, rocks, crab. Find your own words too. See if you can write the initial sound for each one.

Put some initial letters of objects you have at home in a bag. Pick one and read the letter. See if you can match it with the correct object.

Can you create your own fish using different materials? What patterns will your fish have? Use words like: stripy, curly, spotty etc Write their first letter next to them e.g. stripy fish: s

### Communication and language

What is your favourite sea creature? Can you describe it? What is it you like about it?

If you were a fish, where would you want to live? Pond, sea, river or a tank? Why?
