What are their personalities like?</p>  <p>You're on holiday in the Arctic. Send your family a letter telling them what it's like there. What did you do on your holiday? What animals did you see?</p> <p>We learnt that the Arctic circle is slowly melting due to climate change. Make a poster telling people about it! What can we do to help slow it down? Why do we need to protect it?</p>	<p>In Black History Month we learnt about the explorer Matthew Henson. How do you think he felt? What would you have done to make sure he was recognised at the time?</p> <p>Roald Amundsen was the first man to make it to the South pole! He raced a British team and won!
