

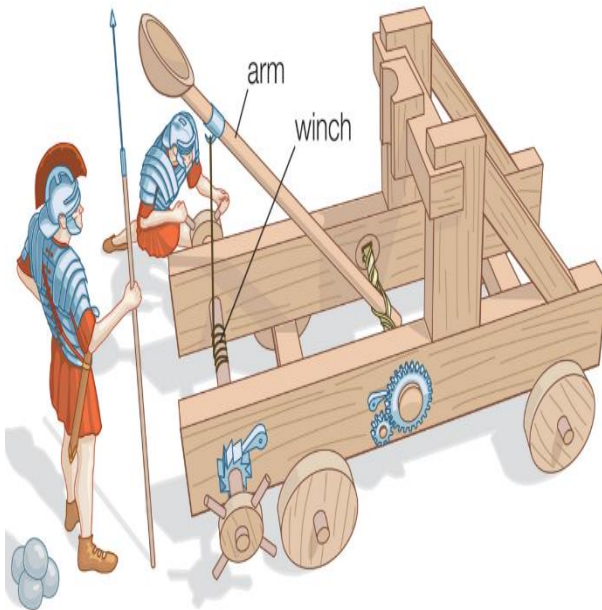
Weekly Tasks/Activities for Home Learning

George gets £1 a day for washing the dishes. He says, "In 12 weeks, I will have £80." Is George correct? Explain why or why not...

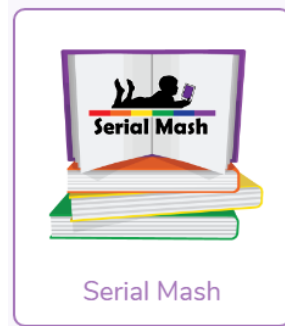

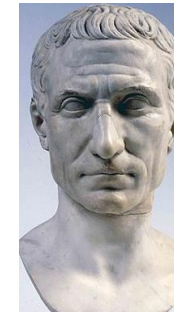

Extensions:

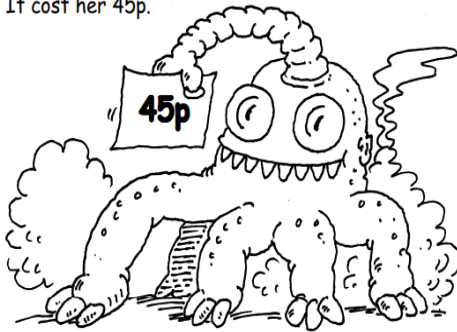
- The Romans are famous for their mosaics.

Each stamp was either 10p or 5p.

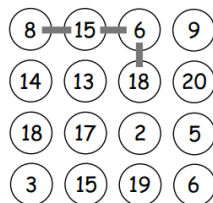


How many of each stamp did Tilly stick on her parcel?
