RE: YEAR 6 Phased re-opening of Schools – Monday 1st June 2020

Dear Parents/ Carers of Year 6 Children,

Please find within this letter further details of your child's return to school. This letter only applies to children in Year 6. If you have children in any other year group in the school, they are not permitted back into school until their individual year group start date. It is important that the school takes a slow and steady approach to introducing children back into the school for the safety of the whole school community. I apologise if this may cause some inconvenience to some families at this time.

It is really important to say that any plans for re-opening are subject to a change of date. If there is any evidence that states it is not safe for children to return to school, you will receive communication as soon as possible.

Taking into account all of the information and guidance that has been provided to support schools to open more safely – within this letter, I will provide you with key information that must be adhered to at all times during the re-opening of the school:

• Children's Classes

To make the classes as small as possible and in order to actively encourage social distancing to the best of our ability, children have been re-arranged into small groups – or bubbles. Therefore, your child will not be returning to their typical class as usual. Due to safety of children and staff, no bubbles will be swapped during this period. Also, your child may not have their usual class teacher or TA. Further to this, they may not be in their typical classroom. Upon arrival on the 1st June, your child will be told which bubble they have been allocated to – where they will meet their teacher, TA and fellow classmates for the remainder of the academic year.

• School Start and Finish Times:

Children will be staggered into the school and out of the school. Please see the table below for your child's start and finish time. Please avoid arriving early or late into school – as we very much want children to avoid unnecessary contact all given opportunities:

The school will be closed to children by 12:45pm every Friday. This will allow for additional cleaning, organisation and administration, which cannot be undertaken whilst children are on site.















• Parent/ Carer on site

At the start of the day, no parents/ carers will be permitted onto school grounds for Year 6 pupils. If you are dropping your child to school, please say goodbye to your child at the gate. At the end of the day, if you are collecting your child, you may enter onto the school site but please wait in the specified playground above. Do not congregate in groups and please observe social distancing measures. Please ensure that the gate remains clear at all times. Children will be brought from their classrooms and dismissed to you. It is imperative that you leave the site as quickly as possible so all public areas are cleared for everyone's safety.

If children already have permission to walk home alone – this will still be granted at this time. If you have not previously applied for consent for your child to walk home alone, and now wish to consider this, then please contact the school office via telephone or email and a form will be sent home to you to complete.

At no point should any parent/ carer enter a school building, unless specifically instructed to by a member of staff.

• Attendance

As you have now decided to return your child to school, it is important you keep in touch with the school regarding your child's attendance. It will be anticipated that your child will attend school for five days per week. If for any reason your child is not coming to school, then you must contact the school to explain the child's absence. If you do not call us, we will call you. If you do not want your child to attend school anymore, then please also inform us of your decision and we will remove your child from our list. Children will be expected to wear full school uniform whilst in school.

• Illness and Covid-19 Symptoms

It is important that you keep regular checks of your child's health, as I am sure you are already doing. Key signs for Covid-19 remain as high temperature and/ or a new continuous cough. If your child is unwell or presents any of these symptoms then please <u>do not</u> send your child into school. If your child or any members of your household show any symptoms of Covid-19, you are all to self-isolate for 14 days. You should also seek medical advice, as testing is now fully underway. Please ensure you contact the school office to inform us as soon as possible of any confirmed cases of Covid-19 in your household.

• Early Collection of Children/ Late Drop off

In order to minimise the movement throughout the school, we will only be allowing early collection of children in exceptional and unexpected circumstances. Therefore, if you know in advance that your child will need collecting early from school, please keep your child off school for that day and inform the school office. Similarly, the school gates will be open until 9:30am. If you are late to school beyond this time, your child will not be permitted into the school and you will have to take your child home.

Toilets

Children will be allocated specific toilets for children to use. These will be cleaned by cleaning staff during the day and again at night. Children will only be able to use their designated toilets. Please note that there will be no facilities for parents/ carers to use toilets in the school.

Resources

Please ensure your child attends school with a water bottle. Water only is permitted in school – no juice, squash or fizzy drinks. Water fountains will not be available for pupils to



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use at this time. There will be opportunities for children to fill up their water bottles throughout the day.

The school will be providing stationery and equipment per child. However, if you want your child to use their own stationery then we will permit personal pencil cases, if your child has access to one from home. Children will be allocated playtime equipment per bubble – that will not be shared across other bubbles.

• Social Distancing Behaviour

Please ensure that you spend time talking with your child in the lead up to their return about their responsibility to socially distance as best as possible. It is important that children are reminded that they must do their best to keep a 2m distance. Staff will ensure that this is followed but it cannot be guaranteed this will always be the case in each bubble. Staff will ensure that bubbles do not mix during the day.

Classrooms will be organised so that children are spaced out as much as possible, so when learning, they will be adhering to these distances as best as possible. All classes will be given an allocated space to play outside during exercise times and lunchtimes. Teachers may decide to use outdoor spaces for learning activities and these will be co-ordinated carefully to avoid groups using the same space. Children will be asked to wash their hands regularly in their classroom. There will be access to warm water, anti-bacterial soap and hand santizer in all classrooms.

School Office

The school office still remains closed to all parents/ carers unless in emergencies only. Please only visit the school office if absolutely essential. Please continue to email or phone to school if you require assistance.

• Free School Meals Voucher

Once your child starts back at school, you will no longer be issued with a weekly voucher, if you were previously entitled to one. Your child will receive a lunch at school.

School Places:

I would like to remind you that sending your child back to school is your decision. As a school, we have conducted specific risk assessments, and as a result adjusted policies and practices in the best way possible. However, we cannot guarantee this will keep your child fully protect from Covid-19. If at any point you no longer wish for your child to attend school, then please inform the school office at the earliest opportunity.

If you have any questions regarding any of this information, then please do not hesitate to phone or email the school, where a member of staff will be available to assist you.
