# Summer Term Music Enrichment Activities

Children across the school have had opportunities to share their musical talents in a variety of performances this term. Examples include: Rock Steady Live Performance; A Choir Concert at Tooley Street; Recorder and Ukulele Performance in school; and the Water City Music Concert in Borough.

### 'I Can Be' Project

'I Can Be' brings 7 and 8 year-old girls into the world of work, introducing them to inspiring women and helping them to discover the breadth of opportunity around them. The programme gave a group of Year 3 girls the opportunity to research, visit and interview a wide range of female professionals in their workplaces, during their working day. 'I Can Be' has enabled our girls to explore jobs they otherwise may never be exposed to, building their curiosity and confidence along the way.

Teachers planned a range of activities using a variety of physical resources for children to continue to build up their problem solving and reasoning skills.
