To measure the perimeter of any shape, you need to measure all of the sides.

To measure the perimeter of a rectangle, you can measure the length and width, add them together, then multiply by 2

## E.g. <br> 8 cm <br> $$
\begin{aligned} \text { Perimeter } & =(8+3) \times 2 \\ & =22 \mathrm{~cm} \end{aligned}
$$
