Writing Flashbacks

Flashbacks are usually used after something important has happened or has been revealed in the story. They take the reader **back in time**.

Flashbacks are usually used to help to explain or to add detail to events that are currently happening in the story.



Answer: Flashbacks help to answer a reader's questions.



Relevant: Flashbacks are relevant to the story.



Clear: It is clear that a flashback is about to begin.
