<p><b>Learning Overview</b></p>			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children will learn to log on to the computers using the Year Group username.</li> <li>• They will learn how to double click on the Purple mash shortcut to open the website and select their class, name and the login to their personal work area.</li> <li>• The children will learn how to set up their avatar in Purple Mash.</li> <li>• Children will navigate the tools menu and open 2Publich and then using the 'He said, she said' template insert their avatar into the document by selecting clipart and adding their avatar by dragging onto the document. They should be shown how to resize their picture by clicking and dragging the 'handles' and shown how they can recolour clipart by selecting the colour wheel.
