In D&T children will have the opportunity to develop their textiles skills learnt in Year 1, learning how to join materials to create a pair of gloves, developing their stitching skills further.

## National Curriculum

- I can evaluate and assess existing products and those that have been made using a design criterion.
- I can investigate different techniques for stiffening a variety of materials and explore different methods of enabling structures to remain stable.

## Learning Overview

- Product analysis of a range of different gloves e.g. medical, woollen, leather, football, bike riding, oven gloves etc
- Discuss the usage of them and the materials they are made from
- Discuss and evaluate the suitability of the materials used
- Children to design a pair of gloves which could be used in cold weather, thinking about the properties of the materials they will use
- Children learn basic sewing stiches e.g. running stitch and practise sewing fabric together
- Children make a template to use when making their gloves
- Use sewing techniques to make a prototype of a pair of gloves
- Children evaluate their prototypes and discuss how they would modify them if they were to make the gloves
